


Just like Martin Luther King, Jn. centuries before, Nano had a dream!

The phrase "all in my power" occurs at least ten times in Nano's Letters.


An unrelenting spirit, with a bold sense of self. A risk taker with the passion to see her school's succeed.

- Nano found and nurtured many companions as trusted friends and willing sisters to join her and sustain her in her life's work. So too must we!




Creative and Courageous






