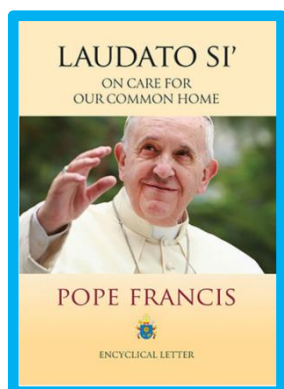
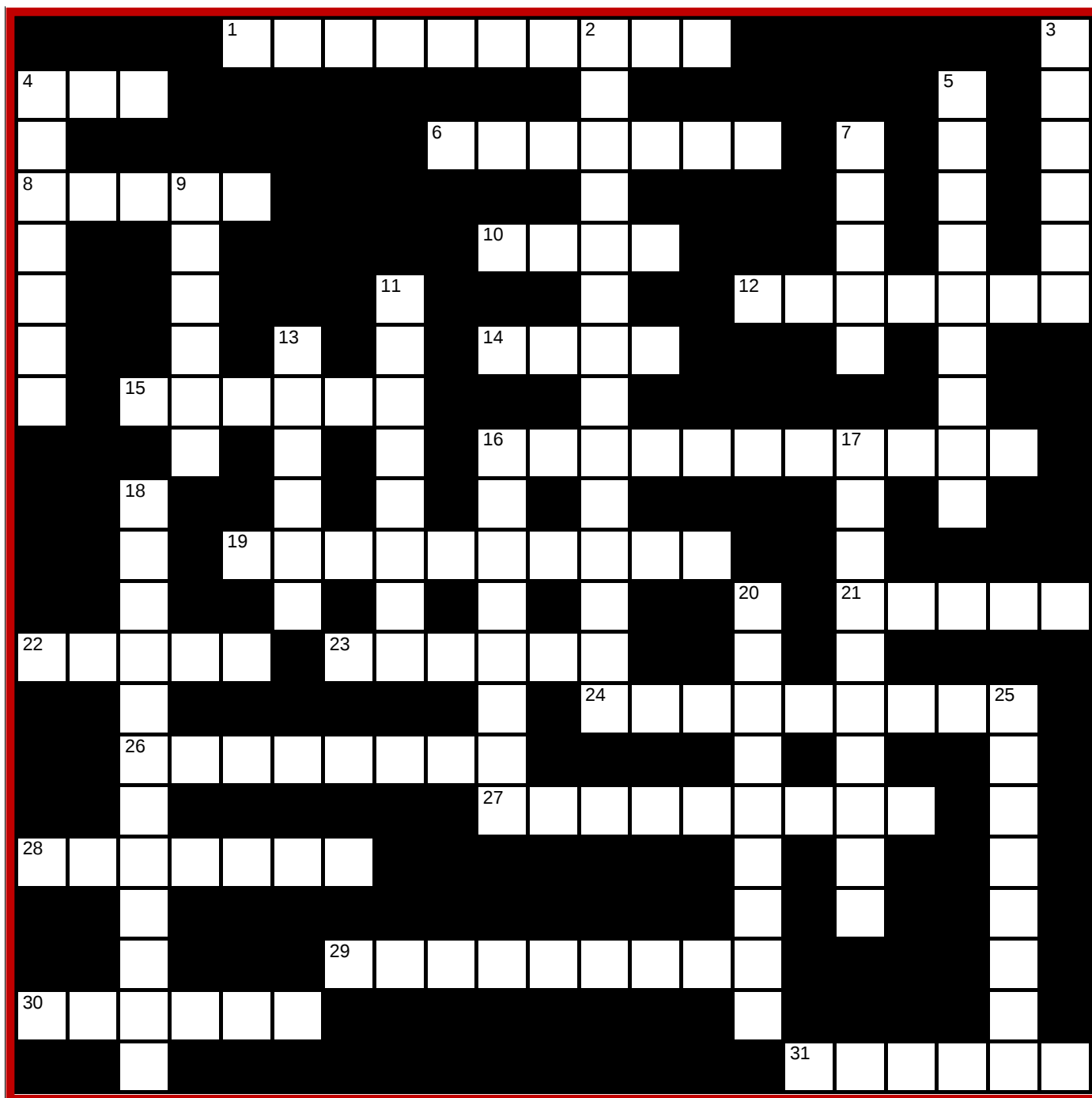

The Reflection Walk won the Catholic Education Western Australia People’s Award in 2022. Designed for a local and global audience, the thirteen stations are accessible in three modes: a face-to-face guided tour, a self-guided in-person tour using QR codes or an online tour.
