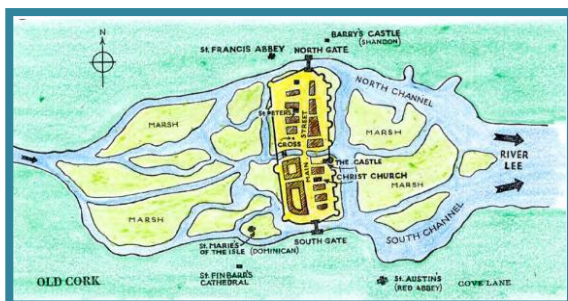
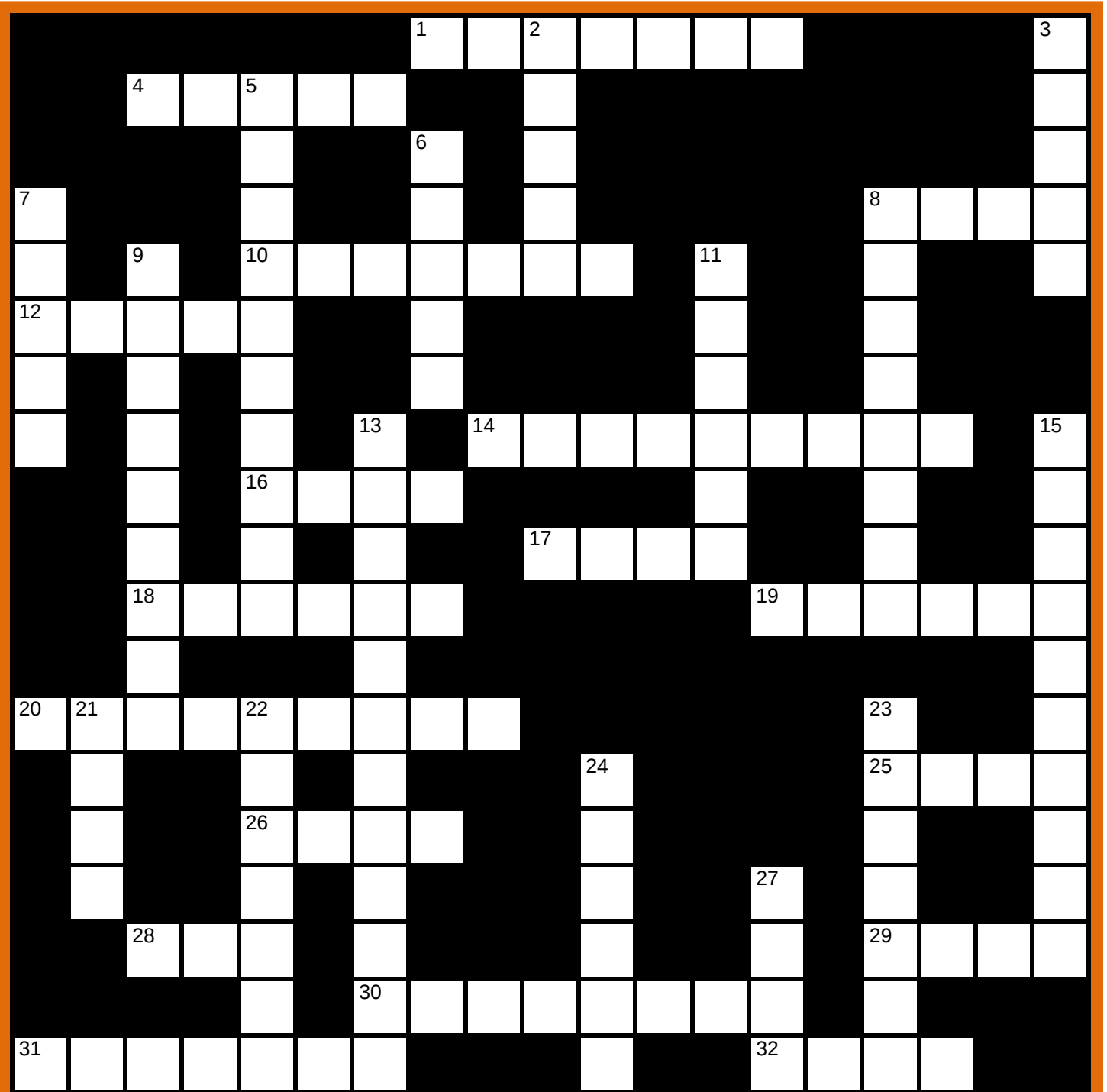


Nano's Cork



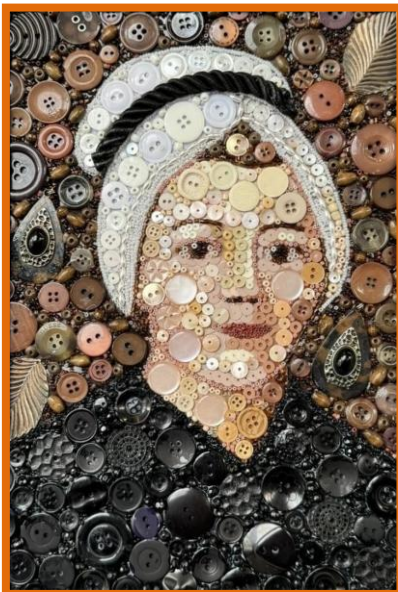

This incredible Nano Nagle portrait created by a year-7 Australian student, **Tilliana**, won an award from Star of the Sea College. The artwork in the competition had to be a portrait representing a significant person in the artist's life. Portraits had to be presented on recycled or repurposed objects and employ materials and mediums in line with the '**Reused, Recycled**' theme. **Tilliana**, the creator of this phenomenal piece writes: 'In my portrait I chose to use mixed media which includes recycled buttons and beads in different shades of colours. I chose to use this medium because it has a 3D element to it and all of the buttons and beads I used are recycled materials, from necklaces and button jars which I thrifted from the Op Shop. I used smaller brown, black and white beads for the eyes, nose and lips and larger beads and buttons in other areas such as her cheeks, bonnet, tunic and the background.'
