


Why a Reflection Walk?

- To provide an opportunity for members of our school community to understand more deeply the connection between the Venerable Nano Nagle narrative, the life and ministry of our Western Australian Presentation Sisters at Iona and our call to action as Presentation People.
- To provide a local pilgrimage opportunity centred around our Presentation charism.
- To provide a structured reflection experience on campus that alerts the participants to the 'signs of holiness' that form part of our lona Presentation story.







Project Phases

Ideation and Planning (2018 – 2019)

- Ideation and Research

Phase 1: Physical Stations (2020)

- Writing of Station Narratives
- Installation of Physical Stations around the Campus

Phase 2: Audiovisual Online (2021)

- Design and Construction of the Online Reflection Walk Pilgrimage
- Recording of Sisters' narrating each station

Working Approach to each Phase


- Intentional that the project would be collaborative in nature working with several internal and external stakeholders.
- Contemporary mural was painted in situ on campus over a period of 4 weeks with students and staff walking past each day watching it evolve.
- Regular consultation occurred with the Presentation Sisters throughout all stages of the project.

Strategies for Success

- Don't underestimate the role of the Project Manager; you need someone who will 'weave the threads' together.

- Be clear on the purpose for which the Walk is being developed and who your audience is.
- Leave space for the Walk to evolve as time progresses.
- Consider how the Walk will be safeguarded and cared for into the future.
