





### Professor Deirdre Raftery

Professor Raftery is a historian of education at University College Dublin, Ireland. She is an elected Fellow of the Royal Historical Society and was a Visiting Fellow at the University of Oxford and the University of Toronto. She also held a Fulbright at Boston College. Her 13 book publications include the acclaimed Nano Nagle, the Life and the Legacy. Other recent books include Irish Nuns and Global Education: a Transnational History 1830-1930 (2023), Teresa Ball and Loreto Education: Convents and the Colonial World, 1794-1875 (2022), and New Turns in the History of Education in Ireland: From Policy to Practice, from Theory to Lived Reality (2023).
